Heard Mr. D.K. Baidhya, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. D.P. Goswami, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, Assam, for the State respondent.

2. This is an application filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik

Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, praying for granting of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner namely, **Anwar Khan**, in connection with **Dispur P.S. Case No. 420/2026** under Section 329(4)/ 74/ 115(2)/ 315(3) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

3. As per allegation made in the FIR, the petitioner entered into the house of the informant and physically assaulted the informant's family members as a result of which the mother-in-law of the informant sustained injury to her neck and arm.

4. Call for the case diary.

5. Having regard to the nature of allegation, it is provided that in the event of his arrest of the petitioner named above, he shall be released on pre-arrest bail on furnishing a bond of Rs. Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand) only with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting authority in connection with the aforementioned case, subject to the following conditions that:-

- (i) the petitioner shall appear before the I.O. within 10 (ten) days from today.
- (ii) the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by the Investigating Officer as and when required;
- (iii) the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or any other police officer, and

(iv) the petitioner shall not hamper with the investigation or tamper with the evidence of the case.

6. List the matter again on **06.08.2026**.
