Heard Shri HR Ahmed, learned counsel for the petitioner.

It is the case of the petitioner that the subject land measuring 3K 3L covered by Dag No. 1007 at Village-Kathaldi Part-III under Bilasipara Revenue Circle was owned by the petitioner's grand-father, namely, Sahar Fakir @ Sehar Fakir @ Sahar Ali Sk as tenant. However, the said land was a part of the acquisition proceeding for the purpose of granting to landless persons. The land, however, remained in the possession of the petitioner as claimed by him. The petitioner has, accordingly prayed for direction for regularizing his possession over the plot of land in question.

Issue notice, returnable by 4 weeks.
