Indifference to the earlier order dated 28.07.2025 passed in WP(C) 3599/2023

Mr. P. Nayak, learned Addl. Advocate General, Assam submits that instructions has already been issued from the Department of Food & Civil Supplies to the Administrative Officer cum Registrar, Assam State Consumer Dispute Redressal Commission, Guwahati to release the dues found to be payable to the petitioner.
