ORDER

1. Heard Mr. D. Dutta, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. D. P. Goswami, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.
2. This petition under Section 482 BNSS, 2023 is filed for granting the

privilege of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner, namely, **Mamata Majhang**, apprehending arrest in connection with Bharalumukh P.S. Case No. 69/2026 under Sections 61(2)/318(4)/336(3)/340(2)/316(2) of the BNS, 2023.

3. Upon perusal of the FIR, it appears that the informant side as well as the petitioner/accused were partners of the firm carrying on the business of trading Fast-Moving Consumer Goods (FMCG) as well as IMFL but later on disputes arose between them and some of which were also referred to Arbitration.
4. The crux of the present FIR relates to Deed of Dissolution of partnership and the informants herein deny the genuineness of the same and allege that the signatures therein are forged. The documents have already been placed before the Civil Judge Senior Division No.2 in Misc. (Arb.) Case No. 04/2026.
5. Mr. D. Dutta, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the dispute in question is entirely of a civil nature and that compromise talks are also underway between the parties. In this regard, attention has been drawn to Annexure-IX annexed to the instant bail application.
6. Subsequently, however, since the FIR has been registered the petitioner has been compelled to approach this Court by way of the instant application apprehending arrest.
7. Call for the case diary.
8. The co-accused of this case, namely, Pushpa Majhang, has been

granted interim pre-arrest bail by this Court under its order dated 15.06.2026 passed in AB No. 1299/2026.

9. Having regard to the nature of the allegations it is provided that in the event of her arrest, the petitioner named above, she shall be released on interim pre-arrest bail, in connection with the above noted case, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 1,00,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting authority, subject to the following conditions:-

(i) It is further provided that the petitioner shall appear before the I.O. within a period of 10(ten) days from today for the purpose of interrogation.

(ii) It is further provided that the petitioner shall not try to temper with the evidence or influence the witnesses in any manner.

10. List this matter again on 20.07.2026.
