1. Heard learned Counsel Mr. S. Alim for the accused-applicant. Also heard Mr. M.P.Goswami, learned Addl.Public Prosecutor for the respondent State.
2. This is an application under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 praying for grant of pre-arrest bail to the accused-applicant, namely, Pritam Basak in connection

with the Bongaigaon P.S. Case No. 81/2026, registered under Sections 126(2)/117 (2)/109 of the BNS, 2023.

3. An FIR was lodged on 25.04.2026 by the informant alleging *inter alia* that on the night of 24.04.2026, at about 11.30 p.m., the accused applicant had rebuked him with obscene words and also grievously injured him and assaulted him with stone without any reasons. On the basis of the FIR, police has registered the Bongaigaon P.S. Case No. 81/2026.

4. Case Diary in the instant case is produced.

5. After perusal of the Case Diary and on hearing the submissions of the respective parties, this Court is of the considered opinion that the accused-applicant should be granted bail at this stage.

6. Accordingly, it is directed that in the event of the arrest of the accused-applicant named above in connection with the aforesaid case, he shall be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs.30,000/- with a suitable surety of like amount to the satisfaction of arresting authority, subject to the following conditions:

i) The accused-applicant shall appear before the investigating officer within a period of 7 days of passing of this order;

ii) The accused-applicant shall co-operate with the investigation and make himself available as and when called for by the investigating officer; and

iii) The accused-applicant shall not try to tamper or

hamper with the evidence whatsoever.

7. In terms of the above directions, the anticipatory bail application is disposed of.
8. Send back the Case Dairy.
