Heard Mrs. RS Deuri, learned counsel for the petitioners, who submits that by filing this writ petition, the petitioner has sought for a direction to the respondent authorities concerned to finalize the selection process that was initiated for filling up the post of Anganwadi Helpers in 21 (twenty one)

centres under the office of the Child Development Project Officer, Mushalpur, Baksa, vide an advertisement, dated 16.07.2025.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the interview was held on 06.08.2025 by the constituted selection process, but till date, there is no outcome of the selection.

In view of above, issue notice of motion, returnable on 27.08.2026.

Mr. BC Mushahary, learned Standing Counsel, BTC accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 2, 4, 5, 6 & 7, while Mr. R Dhar, learned Additional Senior Government Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 & 3. No formal notice is required.

Petitioners to serve requisite extra copies of the writ petition to the learned counsels appearing for the respondents today within 2 (two) days.

On the next returnable date, the respondents concerned shall file their response stating the status of the selection and also the manner in which approval is to be given after a recommendation is made by the constituted selection committee.
