ORDER

Date : 17.07.2026

Heard Mr. P. Bordoloi, learned counsel, appearing for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. D. Saikia, learned Senior Counsel, and learned Senior Standing Counsel, North Cachar Hills Autonomous Council, assisted by learned counsel, Ms. P. Baruah.

2. The petitioner in the present writ petition has assailed an order dated 04.07.2026, by which she has been released from the services of the N.C. Hills Autonomous Council, in pursuance to a decision arrived at in the matter by the Council.

3. The materials brought on record reveals that the petitioner was appointed in pursuance to a regular selection of process and against a regular sanctioned vacant post.

4. A perusal of the order dated 04.07.2026, however does not reveal the reason as to why the services of the petitioner was directed to be terminated by the Council.

5. Ms. P. Baruah, learned counsel, assisting Mr. D. Saikia, learned Senior Counsel, and learned Senior Standing Counsel, appearing for the NC Hills

Autonomous Council, submits that she would complete her instructions in the matter by the next returnable date.

6. To facilitate Ms. P. Baruah, learned counsel, to complete her instructions in the matter and apprise this Court about the reasons relating to the issuance of the order dated 04.07.2026, Registry is directed to list this matter again on **05.08.2026.**

7. Considering the fact that the petitioner was appointed in pursuance to a regular process of selection and against a regular sanctioned vacant post, till the next returnable date, the order dated 04.07.2026, shall remain stayed. However, the present interim order would be re-considered on the next date of listing, on Ms. P. Baruah, completing her instructions.
