Heard Mr. S.Z.B. Aklas, learned counsel for the appellants.

2. In this appeal, under Section 23 of the Railway Claims Tribunal Act, the appellants have put to challenge the correctness or otherwise of the order dated 30.05.2025, passed by the learned Railway Claims Tribunal, Guwahati Bench, in MA 31/2025, arising out of OAIU-78/2023.

3. It is to be noted here that vide order dated 30.05.2025, the learned Tribunal had dismissed the application filed by the appellant for premature release of the compensation amounts, which has been kept in fixed deposit for the applicant in the bank account of respondent No. 2.

4. Perused the memo of appeal as well as the grounds mentioned therein and also perused the order dated 30.05.2025, passed by the learned Tribunal, in MA 31/2025, arising out of OAIU-78/2023.

5. Admit.

6. Let notice be issued to the respondents, within a week from today, returnable in 4 weeks, by registered post with A/D as well as by usual process.

7. The Registry shall call for the record from the learned Tribunal.

8. List the matter after 4 (four) weeks.
