Learned counsel Ms. B. Sharma appears on behalf of Mr. P.J. Saikia, learned counsel for the petitioner. Heard.

Perused the records.

Perusal of the instant case record reveals that the earlier Lawazima Court vide its order dated 06.10.2023 had directed the petitioner to take fresh steps for issuance of notice to the respondent No. 6, within one week of the said order.

Thereafter, when the instant matter was listed again before the Lawazima Court on 18.06.2025, the said Lawazima Court was pleased to allow the petitioner further one week time to comply with the Lawazima Court's order dated 06.10.2023.

However, ***the learned counsel Ms. B. Sharma appearing on behalf of the petitioner before the Lawazima Court today prays for some more time to take fresh steps for service of notice upon the respondent No. 6.***

In view of the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner is granted 7 (seven) days time as a last and final opportunity to take fresh steps for service of

notice upon the respondent No. 6 by way of registered post with A/D mode, as prescribed by the earlier order of the Hon'ble Court dated 17.11.2017. Let the matter be listed again before the Lawazima Court on 21st of August, 2025.
