Heard Mrs. A. Bujarbaruah, learned counsel for the petitioners. Also heard Ms. R. B. Bora, learned Standing Counsel, BTC and Ms. S. Sarma, learned Standing Counsel, Health & Family Welfare Department, Assam appearing for the respondents.

After hearing the submissions advanced by learned counsel for both the sides it is not clear as to which is the Grade-IV post presently held by the petitioners in both these writ petitions. It is also not clear as to whether, their conditions of service is governed by any Service Rule and if so, what is that Service Rule. Unless there is clarity on the aforesaid aspect of the matter, the question of considering the prayer of the writ petitioners for promotion cannot be considered by this Court.

Under the circumstances and taking note of the request made by learned counsel for both the sides, hearing of these writ petitions stand adjourned for three weeks so as to enable the respective counsel to examine these issues and come up with clear answers.
