Case taken up before the Lawazima Court.

None appears on behalf of the petitioner.

Perused the records.

Perusal of the instant case record reveals that notice was issued to the respondent Nos. 4, 5 & 6 by way of registered post with A/D on 11.08.2022.

However, in the meantime, it appears that the learned counsels have already entered appearance on behalf of the respondent No. 5 by filing Vakalatnama. As such, it may be said that **service in respect of the respondent No. 5 has been completed.**

Further, as for the aforementioned notice issued to the respondent Nos. 4 & 6, it appears that:-

Respondent No. 4:- In this regard, it appears that neither the A/D card nor any unserved notice has been received by the concerned section till date. Additionally, the postal

track consignment details regarding the said notice are also not available at the Indian Post Website.

*Respondent No. 6:– In this regard, it appears that the notice has been received unserved with the following postal remark:– **"Incomplete Address, RTS"**.*

In view of the above, the petitioner is directed to take necessary steps for obtaining instructions regarding the proper and complete address of the respondent No. 6, within 7 (seven) days from the date of this order.

Further, the petitioner is afforded 7(seven) days time to take fresh steps for service of notice upon the respondent No. 4 by way of registered post with A/D mode.

Let the matter be listed again before the Lawazima Court on 16.10.2025.
