ORDER

Date : 21.11.2025

Case taken up before the Lawazima Court.

None appears on behalf of the petitioner.

Perused the records.

Perusal of the instant case record reveals that the earlier Lawazima Court vide its order dated 18.09.2025 had directed the petitioner to take fresh steps for issuance of notice to the respondent No. 4 by way of registered post with A/D, within 7 (seven) days from the date of the said order.

Vide the said order, the petitioner was also directed to obtain instructions regarding the proper and complete address of respondent No. 6.

Thereafter, when the instant matter was listed again before the Lawazima Court on 16.10.2025, the said Lawazima Court was pleased to afford the petitioner further 7 (seven) days time to comply with the directions of the aforementioned Lawazima Court's order dated 18.09.2025.

However, a perusal of the recent office note dated 21.11.2025 reveals that the petitioner has not yet taken any steps for issuance of notice to the respondent No. 4, despite being repeatedly directed to that effect. Further, no one from the petitioner's side has appeared before the Lawazima Court today to furnish details regarding the address of respondent No. 6

In view of the observations made above, it may be discerned that the petitioner may not be interested to pursue the case. As such, the matter is laid before the Hon'ble Court for necessary orders.
