ORDER

Date : 12.02.2026

Case taken up before the Lawazima Court.

Learned counsel Mr. R. Sarma appears on behalf of the petitioner. Heard.

Perused the records.

Perusal of the recent office note dated 11.02.2026 reveals that notice was issued to the respondent No. 4 by way of speed post with A/D as well as by usual process on 02.12.2025.

Now, in respect of the above mentioned notices issued to the respondent No. 4, this Lawazima Court has observed as follows:—

(i) In respect of the notice issued through usual process, it appears that no report reflecting the service status has been received by the registry till date.

(ii) Similarly, neither the A/D card nor any un-served notice has been received in respect of the notice issued through speed post with A/D.

However, it appears that the postal track consignment report regarding the above mentioned notice has been generated and the same has been annexed with the case record

at **Flag-'P' in the Part-II file**. Now, a perusal of the said postal tracking report reveals that notice in respect of the respondent No. 4 has been delivered on 08.12.2025.

In view of the observations made above, it may be presumed that **service of notice upon the respondent No. 4 has been completed.**

Further, it has been observed that the earlier Lawazima Court vide its order dated 18.09.2025 had directed the petitioner to take necessary steps for obtaining instructions regarding the proper and complete address of the respondent No. 6.

Now, in regard to the above mentioned respondent No. 6, **the learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr. R. Sarma has appeared before the Lawazima Court today and submitted that the respondent No. 6, i.e., "The State Level Selection Board" is being represented by the respondent No. 2, i.e., "The Director of Secondary Education, Assam" in the instant petition. The learned counsel further submitted that, since learned standing counsel is already representing the respondent No. 2 in the instant petition, the service of notice upon the respondent No. 6 may be presumed to be completed as well.**

In view of the above submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the matter is laid before the Hon'ble Court for necessary orders.
