Heard Mr. D Gogoi, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard the

learned Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State of Assam.

2. This is an application under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023 praying for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner, namely, Ezaz Ahmed in connection with Howly Police Station Case No. 110/2026 registered under Sections 70(2)/351(2)/318(2) of the BNS, 2023 and under Section 6 of the POCSO Act, 2012.

3. The brief case of the petitioner is that on 08.07.2026 at about 10:42 p.m., one complainant namely Tupia Boro, S/o Lt. Sathiram Boro, Vill-Hothapara, P.S-Barpeta Road, District-Barpeta (Assam), and Manabjewti Nath, S/o Sadananda Nath, Vill-Gamari Guri, P.S-Barpeta Road, District-Barpeta (Assam), lodged an FIR stating that on 08.07.2026 at about 9:00 a.m., the FIR-named accused persons called the complainants' minor daughters namely Himashri Boro (Aged 14 years) and Richita Nath to come to Howly Town. When the victim girls reached Howly Town, the accused persons introduced themselves as Hindu Bengalis and they took the victim girls to Kaziranga Dabha, Itervita. Afterward, the accused persons threatened the victim girls and forcefully raped them against their will. The relatives of the victim girls found them near Howly Sahid Bedi, apprehended the accused person Maidul Islam, and handed him over to the police. Hence the case.

- 4.** Call for the CD.
- 5.** Having regard to the fact that the petitioner is not an FIR named accused it is provided that in the event of his arrest, he shall be released on interim pre-arrest bail on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 50,000/- with two sureties of the like amount subject to the satisfaction of the arresting authority.
- 6.** It is directed that the petitioner shall not try to intimidate the victims or influence the witnesses in any manner and shall cooperate with the investigation as and when required.
- 7.** It is further provided that the petitioner shall appear before the I.O. within a period of 10 days from today.
- 8.** List the matter again on 24.08.2026.
