Heard Mr D Nandi, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners. Also heard Ms N Bordoloi, learned Standing Counsel, Revenue Department, appearing on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 and 3; Mr N Das, learned Government Advocate for the respondent Nos. 4, 5, 6 and 11; Ms G Bora, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent No. 2; Mr S Bora, learned Standing Counsel, GMC, appearing on behalf of respondent Nos. 7 and 8, and Mr M H Ahmed, learned counsel appearing for the respondent Nos. 9 and 10.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that he would like to file an

additional affidavit to bring on record, a communication dated 12.05.2023, which was inadvertently not brought on record in the writ petition or in the additional affidavit filed on 19th of July, 2025.

3. The learned counsel for the respondents have submitted that they would file consolidated response to the writ petition and the additional affidavits filed by the writ petitioners, which will facilitate the adjudication of the matter.

4. The petitioners are allowed a period of 2 (two) weeks' time to file additional affidavit, as proposed.

5. The respondents may file their response to the writ petition and the additional affidavits filed by the petitioners, within a period of 3 (three) weeks thereafter.

6. Since the matter relates to a tussle for land between a school and the respondent authorities, and has already suffered several rounds of litigations, list this matter again in the second week of December, 2025, by which time, all the parties would ensure filing of their pleadings.

7. It is made clear that no further time would be granted to any of the parties to file affidavit-in-opposition or additional affidavits. After filing of the affidavit-in-opposition, the learned counsel for the petitioner may file their response in the form of an affidavit-in-reply, prior to the next date of listing.

8. The learned counsel for the petitioners has consented to serve extra copies of the writ petition and the additional affidavits in requisite numbers to the learned counsel for the respondents for their doing the needful.
