Heard Mr. M. Ali, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.
Also heard Mr. D. P. Goswami, learned Additional Public Prosecutor
appearing for the State respondent.

This is an application under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023, for
granting pre-arrest bail to the accused/petitioners, i.e., **Rahul Ali**, who

is apprehending arrest in connection with **Boko P.S. Case No. 94/2025** registered under **Sections 491/ 406/ 420/ 384** of the IPC.

The case of the prosecution is that one Lachit Alam had collected money from the aspirant students on the pretext of giving them job. Accordingly, a case was registered against the said person and during the course of interrogation of the accused, the Investigating Officer had asked the present petitioner to appear before him within 2 (two) days. However, he failed to appear. Thereafter on several occasions, the police allegedly visited the accused/petitioner's house and asked his family members to produce him before the Investigating Officer, failing which they allegedly threatened to arrest him.

Call for the case diary, fixing the matter on 14.09.2026.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and in the interim, it is provided that, in the event of arrest of the accused/petitioner, named above, in connection with the aforesaid case, he shall be released on interim pre-arrest bail on furnishing a bail bond of **Rs. 15,000/-** with one suitable surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting authority, subject to the following conditions:

- I) That the accused/petitioner shall appear before the Investigating Officer within 10 days, failing which on and from the 11th day, the interim pre-arrest bail order shall have no force;

ii) That the accused/petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer.

Iii) That the accused/petitioner shall not hamper or tamper with the evidence;

iv) That the accused/petitioner shall refrain from committing any similar offences in future of which he is accused or suspected of commission.
