Heard Mr. S. M. Abdullah. P., learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. K.K. Parashar, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the State of Assam.

2. This is an application under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023 whereby the

petitioner, namely, Rashidul Hoque is seeking Anticipatory Bail apprehending arrest in connection with an FIR, which is registered as Uluani Police Station Case No. 27/2026 registered under Sections 310(4) of BNS, 2023.

3. An FIR was lodged by one police personnel at Sullung Police Patrol Post, Nagaon District, alleging that the petitioners were found behaving suspicious near a toll gate and they were in a Bolero vehicle and the police searched the vehicle and recovered certain articles like steel pipe, dao, knife, etc. As per the said FIR, it transpires that the said persons were preparing to commit dacoity by targeting cattle transportation vehicles. One of the persons present had managed to escape and that person is the present petitioner.

4. The arrested persons have already been released on regular bail considering the period of detention.

5. Call for the Case Diary.

6. Having regard to the nature of allegation, it is provided that the petitioner in the event of his arrest in connection with this case; he may be allowed to go on interim bail on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand) only with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Arresting Authority.

7. It is further provided that the petitioner shall appear before the Investigating Officer within a period of 10 (ten) days from today for the purpose of interrogation and that he shall not try to influence or intimidate the witnesses or tamper with the evidence in any manner.

8. Violation of any such bail conditions shall entail cancellation of the bail.

9. List this matter again on 02.09.2026.
