Heard Mr. S.M. Sarma, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. R. Dhar, learned Additional Senior Government Advocate for the respondent Nos. 1, 2 and 3 and Mr. P.K. Munir, learned counsel for the respondent Nos. 4, 5 and 6.

Pursuant to the earlier order of the Lawazima Court the petitioner was directed to correct the addresses of the respondent Nos. 8 and 9.

By order dated 04.02.2025 of the Lawazima Court recorded that none represented the writ petitioner and no correct addresses had been furnished.
