Case taken up before the Lawazima Court.

Learned counsel Ms. P. Bora appears on behalf of Mr. R.C. Saikia, learned counsel for the petitioner. Heard.

Perused the records.

Perusal of the office note dated 26.03.2026 reveals that notice was issued to respondent Nos. 6 & 7 by way of registered post with A/D on 30.08.2023.

Now, in regard to the aforesaid notice, this Lawazima Court observes as follows:

(i) *The notice issued to respondent No. 6 has been returned unserved with the following postal remark: "**Insufficient Address, RTS**".*

(ii) *Further, in respect of the notice issued to respondent No. 7, it appears that a response to the notice has been received from the said respondent, which may be perused at **Flag-'RESPONSE'**.*

From the above observations, it is discernible that **service of notice upon**

respondent No. 7 is complete, whereas service of notice upon respondent No. 6 could not be effected.

However, ***learned counsel Ms. P. Bora, appearing on behalf of the petitioner, submits that the petitioner seeks to withdraw the instant case. Accordingly, the learned counsel has prayed for the matter to be placed before the Hon'ble Court.***

In the light of this prayer, the matter is laid before the Hon'ble Court.
