Heard Shri G. Alam, learned counsel for the petitioner, who by means of

this writ petition has challenged an order of termination of settlement of the Rani Meghna Beel in the district of Sribhumi which was settled with him for a period of 7 years. He has submitted that the said termination has been done without taking into consideration the relevant factors. He has also informed that in the meantime, a fresh tender notice dated 31.07.2026 has been initiated.

Let notice be issued, returnable on 14.09.2026.

Shri K. Das, learned counsel appearing on instructions of Shri P. Sarmah, learned Standing Counsel, AFDC accepts notice on behalf of the respondent nos. 1 to 6 and Shri G. Bokolial, learned Government Advocate, Assam accepts notice on behalf of the respondent nos. 7 & 8. Extra copies of the writ petition be served upon the learned counsel for the respondents by tomorrow.

Shri Alam, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for an interim order. He has submitted that if the new settlement is made, pursuant to the tender notice dated 31.07.2026, the subject matter of the writ petition would become infructuous.

Considering the same, while this Court is not inclined to stay the new tender process initiated vide the order dated 31.07.2026, it is directed that, till the returnable date, no orders of settlement be issued. However, there is no restrain on the process which has been initiated.
