- 1.** Heard Mr. B. Kaushik, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr. P. Das, learned counsel on behalf of the informant. Also heard Mr. D.P. Goswami, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.
- 2.** The petitioners were granted interim bail on 11.08.2025, pursuant to which they are stated to have appeared before the I.O and their statements were recorded and the same is confirmed by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.
- 3.** Mr. P. Das, learned counsel on behalf of the informant has submitted certain documents, showing that pursuant to the assault, the victim sustained serious injuries and was treated in more than one hospital and eventually admitted to the ICU of Narayana Multispeciality Hospital. However, it appears that to determine the specific nature of the injuries, a detailed medical report was called for and it is submitted by learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the

State that it is not yet received.

4. Issue fresh requisition for the detailed medical report.
5. The interim bail granted earlier vide order dated 11.08.2025 shall **continue** till next date of listing.
6. List the matter on 17.10.2025.
