Heard Mr. D. K. Roy, learned counsel for the petitioner.

Mr. N. R. Sharma, learned Standing Counsel, BTC, appearing for respondent Nos. 1 & 3, by placing on record a copy of the communication dated 17.03.2026 issued by the Secretary, Bodoland Territorial Council, Kokrajhar, submits that the authorities have decided to regularise the service of the petitioner at par with other similarly situated teachers, subject to availability of a vacant post and accordingly, a request has been made to the Director of Education, BTC, Kokrajhar, to submit a detailed proposal for regularisation of the petitioner as an Assistant Teacher in any available vacant post.
