Heard Mr. A. Mannaf, learned counsel for the accused applicant and Mr. B. Sharma, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State of Assam.

2. This is an application filed under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023, praying for grant of pre-arrest bail to the accused applicant in connection with Boko P.S.

Case No. 67/2026, registered under Sections 61(2)(b)/217/240/264/318(4)/336(3) of the BNS, 2023.

3. An FIR was lodged on the basis of a complaint by the Bajaj Allianz General Insurance Company Ltd., alleging, *inter alia*, that the accused applicant's husband who expired on a motor accident, has submitted a false claim by giving certain false details.

4. On the basis of the FIR, police registered Boko P.S. Case No. 67/2026 under the aforementioned Sections.

5. After considering the materials available on record and the submissions advanced by the learned counsel for the parties, this Court is of the considered opinion that, at this stage, some interim protection should be granted to the accused applicant.

6. Accordingly, it is directed that in the event of the arrest of the accused applicant, namely, *Smti. Pabita Das* in connection with Boko P.S. Case No. 67/2026, she shall be released on interim pre-arrest bail on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.20,000/-(Rupees Twenty thousand) with a suitable surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the Arresting Authority, subject to the following conditions:

- i. that the accused applicant shall appear before the Investigating Officer within a period of 10 (ten) days from today;
- ii. that the accused applicant shall co-operate with the investigation and make herself available as and when called for by the Investigating Officer; and
- iii. that the accused applicant shall not try to tamper or hamper with the investigation in any manner, whatsoever.

7. Call for the Case Dairy.
8. List the matter on **14.09.2026.**
