Heard Shri G. Chamuah, learned counsel for the petitioner.

This matter was listed on 26.08.2026 and considering the grievance which was relating to discontinuation and removal of electricity meter box by the APDCL, Shri K.P. Pathak, learned Standing Counsel, APDCL was directed to obtain instructions.

Shri Pathak, learned Standing Counsel on receipt of instructions has, however, submitted that the correct facts have not been projected at all. He has submitted that there have been instances of theft of electricity for which there was disconnection and on two instances, the petitioner had illegally got the connection and finally, the meter box was seized and the petitioner had refused to sign the seizure report. He has also submitted that an FIR is on the process of being lodged against the petitioner.

This Court is of the view that the aforesaid facts be put on record by way of an affidavit which is to be filed within a period of 2 weeks.

Let this matter be listed for motion on 14.09.2026 for consideration of all the facts.
