Heard Shri SC Pandit, learned counsel for the petitioners.

The petitioners claim that they belong to the PwD category and had participated in a recruitment process for the post of Grade-III of different Departments which was advertised on 30.12.2018. They also claim to have been selected in the select list published on 05.08.2019 but were not appointed.

Though this writ petition was filed in the year 2021, the same has not been moved till date and sufficient time has passed wherein the aspect of validity of the select list would also arise.

Be that as it may, let notice be issued, returnable by 4 weeks.

Shri D Bora, learned State Counsel, Assam accepts notice on behalf of the respondent nos. 1 and 3 whereas Shri SP Das, learned Standing Counsel, Employment and Craftsmen Training accepts notice on behalf of the respondent no. 2.

Extra copies of the writ petition along with its annexures be served upon the learned counsel for the respondents within 2 days.

Shri Das, learned Standing Counsel has submitted that there is no such Department as described against the respondent no. 1.
