**ORDER**

This writ petition was instituted in the year 2022, aggrieved by the report dated 19.04.2022 issued by the Fishery Officer, projecting that the land mentioned therein, including those under occupation of the petitioner was Government Khas land. The petitioner is aggrieved because, according to them, the petitioner had been in occupation of a part of the land through his forefathers by paying revenue and the application for settlement of the land is also pending with the Government.

By the order dated 19.09.2022, status-quo was required to be maintained with regard of the possession of the petitioner's land covered by Dag No. 218 of Khatian No.35. The status-quo order was applicable till the next returnable date and was not continuing thereafter. However, the order was continued by the order dated 01.03.2024 on which date, the learned counsel or the petitioner had prayed for time to file necessary rejoinder against the affidavit-in-opposition filed by the respondent No. 6.

Today, Mr. M.U Mondal, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted

that a short accommodation may be afforded to the file rejoinder affidavit.

Let this matter be listed again on **2<sup>nd</sup> Week of December, 2025** on a date to be fixed by the Registry along with the rejoinder affidavit proposed to be filed by the petitioner. Since the matter relates to the year 2022, no further time will be granted in affording for filing affidavit.
