Heard Mr. S Hoque, learned counsel for the petitioner.

The petitioner claims that he had executed the contract pertaining to Flood Damage Repairing and Ordinary Repairing, PWD, (NH), Abhayapuri construction division, and after due completion he had submitted the bill amounting to Rs.9,86,164.00, however, the same has not been paid till date. Being aggrieved the present writ petition is filed.

Issue notice, returnable by four weeks.

Mr. B Gogoi, learned counsel, accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents.

As all the respondents are duly represented, no formal notice is required to be issued, however, extra copies of the writ petition be served upon the learned counsel for the aforesaid respondents within three days.

On the next date fixed, the learned counsel for the respondents shall obtain instructions and apprise this court whether the amount claimed by the petitioner is admitted by the respondent department or part thereof and if yes, the reason for non-payment of such dues.
