ORDER

Date : 24.11.2025

1. Heard Mr. S.P. Das, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. C Baruah, learned standing counsel, Accountant General and Ms. M Bhattacharjee, learned senior Government Advocate for the State respondents.
2. The grievance of the petitioner is that his pension has not been finalized in respect of his superannuation from service as Lot Mondal from the Office of Deputy Commissioner, Kamrup (M) way back on 30.11.2013
3. From the materials available on record and the affidavits what transpires is that the pension proposal was returned by the Accountant General, A&E to the Deputy Commissioner, Kamrup (M) on the ground that the service of the petitioner from 15.12.1982 to

15.07.1999 was not found updated.

4. In the meantime, affidavits have been exchanged and what is seen is that the District Development Commissioner, Kamrup (M), Guwahati by its communication dated 24.09.2025 sought for necessary guidelines for calculation of the pay of the petitioner on notional basis.

5. Today when the matter is taken up for hearing, both the learned counsel representing the Accountant General as well as the District Development Commissioner submits that the matter will be finalized after a discussion between both the authorities and they are proposing to do it within a period of two weeks.

6. In view of the aforesaid, the matter stands adjourned and be listed again on 19.12.2025, on which date both the learned counsels shall complete their updated instructions as regards the status of payment of pension to the petitioner.
