Heard Mr. S. P. Das, learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner.

Also heard Mr. J. K. Goswami, learned Govt. Advocate, Assam as well as Mr. A. Hasan, learned Standing Counsel, AG, Assam, who submit that instructions are awaited. Mr. Goswami further submits that due to non-furnishing of extra copies, he could not obtain instruction.

The said submission has, however, been strongly refuted by Mr. Das by submitting that adequate number of extra copies have been received by the learned Govt. Advocate by putting his own signature.

Be that as it may, in order to avoid any further delay in the matter and on the request of Mr. Goswami, this matter is directed to be listed again on 07.03.2022. Extra copies of the writ petition be furnished afresh to Mr. Goswami within three days from today by obtaining written acknowledgement.
