Heard Shri B. D. Das, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner assisted by Shri J. Lotha, learned counsel.

The grievance of the petitioner is with regard to the aspect of execution of an order dated 18.08.2022 passed by the respondent no. 3 in Misc. Case/212/2011. It is submitted that though notices were issued from time to time to the private respondents, they had failed to appear and no concrete steps have been taken to conclude the proceedings.

Let **notice** be issued, returnable by **3 (three) weeks**.

Shri H. Sarmah, learned Addl. Senior Govt. Advocate accepts notice on

behalf of respondent nos. 1 to 4.

Extra copies of the writ petition be served upon them within 2 (two) working days.

Steps for service of notice upon the respondent nos. 5, 6, 7 & 8 by registered post with A/D within 2 (two) working days. Additionally, the learned counsel seeks liberty to serve *dasti* upon the private respondents. Liberty to serve *dasti* is granted which is however required to be routed through the Registry of this Court and the notice accompanying the *dasti* should clearly reflect the next date fixed which is 19.09.2025. Prior to the next date fixed, the petitioners are also required to file an affidavit in proof of such *dasti* service.

Pendency shall not be a bar to bring the proceedings in Misc. Case/212/2011 to a logical conclusion.
