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Heard Mr. A. Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. P. Borthakur, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State respondent.

**2.** By this application, the petitioner has prayed for pre-arrest bail in connection with Nagaon P.S. Case No. 439/2025 registered under Section 87 of the BNS.

**3.** The FIR dated 02.06.2025 reveals that the daughter of the informant, who was 17 years of age was induced by the petitioner and was made to elope with him while she was going for tuition.

**4.** Mr. A. Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner and the victim were in relationship and that the parents of the victim were not willing to get their daughter married with the petitioner as he was a businessman and as such, according to him, the petitioner and the victim eloped.

**5.** Mr. P. Borthakur, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State respondent however submits that the victim is minor as she is 17 years of age and that her statement under Section 183 may be seen and as such, prayed for calling of the Case Diary.

**6.** In view of the submissions made by the parties and on perusal of the documents annexed with the petition and more specifically because of the fact that the petitioner and the victim had eloped, this Court deems it fit to release the petitioner on interim pre-arrest bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/-

with 1 local surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting authority under the following conditions:-

1. The petitioner will co-operate with the investigation and will appear before the Investigating Officer as and when called for.
2. The petitioner will not leave his place of residence without the permission of the arresting authority.
- 7.** Call for the Case Diary.
- 8.** List the matter on 25.09.2025.
