Heard Shri L. M. Rahman, learned counsel for the petitioner, whose grievance is with regard to non extension of the NOC dated 23.06.2024 granted by the District Commissioner, Barpeta in connection with sale of land. It is submitted that due to certain computer malfunctioning in the Office of the Deputy Registrar, Barpeta, the Sale Deed could not be registered and in the meantime, the NOC had spent its force on 24.12.2024.
