Heard Mr. I. H. Saikia, learned counsel for the petitioner.

By an order dated 03.09.2025, this Court had directed the learned counsel for the respondents to have the specific instructions on the scope of filing application for extension of NOC along with limitation in such process, if any.

Today, the learned counsel appearing for the respondent has submitted that although they have received certain instructions on the allegations levelled in the writ petition, that specific instruction is still awaited. He accordingly prays that the matter may be taken up after 10 (ten) days allowing him to have his instruction in the matter.
