Heard Mr. S. P. Bhattacharjee, learned counsel for the petitioners, who submits that a bunch of writ petition were taken up for consideration and

disposed of vide a common Order dated 06.01.2026, wherein the lead case was that of the instant petitioner's i.e., WP(C) No. 2644 of 2023. The petitioner, thereafter, upon discovery of a vital document submitted a review petition i.e. Review Petition No. 7 of 2026, which was considered and disposed of by this Court vide Order dated 16.03.2026. Consequently, the Review Court directed that both the Order dated 06.01.2026 as well as the Order dated 16.03.2026 shall be read together.

The petitioner, thereafter, furnished a copy of the Orders to the respondent No. 2, which was received by the said authority on 07.04.2026. However, despite receipt of the same, according to the learned counsel, the direction of this Court has not been carried out and, hence, the petitioner having no alternative has filed the instant contempt petition.

In view of above, issue notice to the respondent No. 2 only at this stage, returnable by four (4) weeks.

Petitioner to take steps for service of notice upon the respondent No. 2 by speed post within three (3) days.

List the matter again after four (4) weeks.
