Heard Shri H. Das, learned counsel for the petitioners.

It is the case of the petitioners that they had purchased two plots of land in the year 1969 vide registered sale deeds and their names were recorded in the *Jamabandi*. However, the respondents have inserted their names in connivance with some authority and thereafter, have filed Misc. Case No. 28/2025 for striking out the names of the petitioners from the records of rights. The petitioners claim to have filed objection and are apprehending that their names would be struck off.

Let notice be issued, returnable by 6(six) weeks.

Ms. PR Mahanta, learned Standing Counsel, Revenue Department accepts notice on behalf of the respondent nos. 1 & 2 and Shri H. Sarma, learned Additional Senior Government Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondent nos. 3 to 7. Extra copies of the writ petition be served upon the learned counsel for the respondents within two days.

Petitioners to take steps for service of notice upon the respondent nos. 8 to 24 by registered post with A/D. Steps within two working days.

List this case after 6(six) weeks.

Pendency shall not be a bar for the authorities to pass final orders in the Misc. Case No. 28/2025 which, however has to be done strictly in accordance with law.
