Heard Mr. S. Hoque, learned counsel for the petitioner, who submits that this is the second time the petitioner is before this Court claiming grant of arrear family pension. The first writ petition being WP(C) No.6789/2013 was disposed of vide order dated 09.03.2015 by directing the respondent authorities concerned to pass necessary orders relating to family pension of the petitioner within a time frame. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant thereto, various communications were made between the office of the Principal Accountant General (A&E), Assam and the Deputy Commissioner, Dhubri up to 20.01.2016, but thereafter, nothing has materialized and therefore, the petitioner having no alternative is once again before this Court.

In view of above, issue notice of motion returnable by four weeks.

Ms. S. Baruah, learned Government Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 3 & 4, while Mr. R. Boro, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2 and Mr. R. Borpujari, learned Standing Counsel, Revenue Department accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 and 5. Notice is therefore complete.

Petitioner to furnish requisite copies of the writ petition to the learned counsel for the respondents within three days.

List the matter again after four weeks.

Registry shall reflect the name of Standing Counsel, Revenue Department in the cause list hereafter.
