The instant matter has been carefully perused and upon such perusal, it has been discerned that the petitioner was directed on multiple occasions by the previous Lawazima Court's orders dated 20.06.2024 & 30.01.2025 respectively, to take fresh steps for service of notice upon the respondent No. 6 by registered post with A/D as well as by usual Court process.

However, perusal of the recent office note dated 20.05.2025 reveals that the petitioner
