Lawazima Court's order dated 20.05.2025 reflects that even after repeated directions issued by the Lawazima Court, the petitioner has not taken any steps for issuance of notice upon the respondent No. 6. Accordingly, the matter is placed before this Court.

The learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes that he will take the require steps by tomorrow i.e. on 27.05.2025.

In view of the aforesaid, the matter stands adjourned and the petitioner is

permitted to take steps upon the respondent No. 6 as directed earlier, by tomorrow i.e. on 27.05.2025. If no such step is taken, the interim order passed earlier on 19.07.2017 directing maintenance of status quo as regards the disputed land shall stand vacated without further reference to this Court.

The learned counsel for the petitioner shall also furnish extra copies of the writ petition to the learned counsel representing the respondent No. 5.

List this matter after four weeks, if such step is taken, with an updated report.
