Learned counsel Mr. P.R. Chakma appears on behalf of Mr. P.K. Das, learned counsel for the petitioner. Heard.

Perused the records.

Perusal of the office note dated 10.09.2025 reveals that notice was issued to the respondent No. 6 by usual Court process and by way of registered post with A/D on 28.05.2025 & 30.05.2025 respectively.

Now, in respect of the aforesaid notices issued to the respondent No. 6, it has been observed as follows:—

(i) *In respect of the notice issued through registered post with A/D, it appears that the notice has been received un-served with the following postal remark:—"Incomplete address R.T.S."*

(ii) *In respect of the notice issued through usual process, it appears that the process server's report of respondent No. 6 has been received by the concerned section and placed at Flag-'UR in Part-II file'. The said service report states that the respondent No. 6 was not found at the given address. Upon enquiry, it has been informed that the respondent No. 6 has since retired and left Haflong.*

In view of the observations made above, the petitioner is directed to take necessary steps for obtaining instructions regarding the present address of the respondent No. 6, within 7 (seven) days from today.

Let the matter be listed again before the Lawazima Court on 19.09.2025.
