ORDER

Date : 07.05.2026

Case taken up before the Lawazima Court.

None appears on behalf of the petitioner.

Perused the records.

Perusal of the recent office note dated 06.05.2026 reveals that notice was issued to the respondent Nos. 1, 2, 3 & 4 by way of registered post with A/D on 28.11.2025 and by way of usual process on 26.09.2025.

Now, in respect of the above mentioned notices issued to the respondent Nos. 1, 2, 3 & 4, this Lawazima Court observes as follows:—

(i) In respect of the notice issued through registered post with A/D, it appears that neither A/D cards nor any un-served notices have been received by the registry till date. Additionally, the postal tracking details regarding the said notice are unavailable in the official website of India Post. Consequently, service of notice issued through registered post with A/D upon respondent Nos. 1, 2, 3 & 4 cannot be presumed at this stage.

*(ii) Further, in respect of the notice issued through usual process, it appears that the process server's reports regarding service of notice upon the respondent Nos. 2, 3 & 4 have been received by this Registry, which have been annexed to the case record at **Flag-'SR' in the Part-III file**. Now, a perusal of these reports reveals that the notices issued to the respondent Nos. 2, 3 & 4 have been received by their respective employees on their behalf and they have acknowledged the receipt of the notice by putting their purported signatures along with the official seal of the respondents on the return copy of the notice.*

However, in respect of the respondent No. 1, it appears that the process server report regarding the said respondent has not been received by the Registry till date.

In view of the observations made above, it may be said that **service of notice upon the respondent Nos. 2, 3 & 4 is completed.**

Further, as far as the respondent No. 1 is concerned, the concerned section is directed to issue a reminder to the appropriate authority requesting to provide the service report of the notice dated 26.09.2025 issued through usual process to the respondent No. 1, within a week from the date of this order.

Let the matter be listed again before the Lawazima Court on 08.06.2026.
