ORDER

1. Heard Mr. S. Ahmed, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. P. Borthakur, learned Additional Public Prosecutor.
2. This petition under Section 482 BNSS is filed by the petitioner, namely, **Khaimul Ali**, apprehending arrest in connection with **Sorbhog**

P.S. Case No. 82/2025 registered u/s **329(4)/62/64/74/76 of BNS, 2023.**

3. The case arose out of an ejahar dated 17.08.2025 alleging that the accused petitioner entered into the house of the informant and tried to commit sexual act with her by using force and upon hue and cry he ran away.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner by drawing attention to paragraph 5 of the bail petition submits that pursuant to separation of the informant from her previous husband she developed a relationship with the petitioner. The petitioner did not know about her previous marriage and upon coming to know, he tried to avoid the relationship and she lodged a false case against him.

5. I have heard the learned Additional Public prosecutor, Assam.

6. Call for the case diary.

7. However, in the facts and circumstances, I am of the view that at this stage, the accused petitioner should be given an opportunity to get his statement recorded before the police.

8. Accordingly, in the **interim**, in the event of arrest of the petitioner named above in connection with above mentioned case, he shall be allowed to go on bail of **Rs. 25,000/-** with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting authority, subject to the following conditions:

(a) shall co-operate with the investigation and appear before the IO;

(b) he shall not intimate or harass the victim or her family member in any matter.
