Heard Mr M I Hussain, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner. Also heard K K Das, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, for the State of Assam.

2. It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that though the petitioners had appeared before the Investigating Officer, as required by the order dated 11.09.2025, his statement has not been recorded, however, the Investigating Officer has

retained the certified copy of the orders of this Court.

3. In view of the above, list this matter again **on 22nd of January, 2026**, by which time, the petitioner, Abdul Rosid shall again appear before the Investigating Officer within a week from today. The condition of pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 11.09.2025, shall remain operative, i.e., in case, in the event of his arrest on his now appearing before the Investigating Officer, he shall be allowed to go on bail on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.20,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Investigating Authority of Bijni P.S. Case No. 99/2025, subject to the following conditions:

- i) That the accused/applicant shall appear before the concerned Investigating Officer within a period of 10(ten) days of passing of this order;
- ii) That the accused/applicant shall not hamper or tamper with the evidence of the instant case in any manner;
- iii) That the accused/applicant shall fully cooperate with the investigation of the case by appearing before the I.O of the case, as and when call for by the I.O.
- iv) That the accused/applicant will not try to establish communication with informant and/or witnesses in any manner whatsoever.
