Heard Mr. A. Narzari, the learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard the learned Standing Counsel appearing for the Health Department; Ms. Tinlung learned Standing Counsel for the Dima Hasao and Mr. S. K. Medhi, learned counsel for the respondent No.6.

The counsel for the petitioner has referred to the additional affidavit from where it appears that the Joint Director, Health Services, Dima Hasao, Halflong had forwarded all the required documents in respect of the petitioner for grant of compassionate family pension to the Accountant General (A&E), Assam, Beltola on 21.02.2025 vide Communication No.E/22-2/2024-25/1009.

The learned counsel appearing for the Dima Hasao counsel has also submitted that the said documents has in fact been sent. There is another document on record by which the petitioner was requested by the Office of the

Accountant General (A&E) Assam to take necessary steps by sending certain documents which are referred to in the letter dated 08.12.2025. The petitioner was required to submit the following documents by the said letter:

“(i) Duly attested Non-Marriage and Non- Employment Certificate in r/o of the applicant from the concerned Circle Officer/ Block Development Officer as provided in P&PG Department's Notification No. PPG(G) 10/2013/49 dated 09/08/2018 may please be furnished.

(ii) An Affidavit/Undertaking from the applicant that there is no other claimant for life time family pension including disabled dependent sons/daughters of Late Thanglien Hmar, Ex. Pharmacist.

(iii) Duly attested passport sized photographs, descriptive rolls, specimen signatures (3 copies each) of the claimant

(iv) In the both halves of the aforementioned PPO the Date of Birth of the claimant was recorded as "28/05/1989" based on the pension papers as received from the concerned department whereas the documents enclosed with the claim states the Date of Birth as "01/05/1993" which may please be clarified by means of an affidavit from the 1st Class Judicial Magistrate.”

The requisite documents have been submitted by the petitioner.

The learned counsel for the petitioner would be at liberty to call for the documents requested by the letter dated 08.12.2025 and supply a copy of the same to Mr. S. K. Medhi, learned counsel appearing for the AG who shall take the pains to forward the same to the Office of the Accountant General.

List the matter again on 20.02.2026, on which date Mr. S. K. Medhi, learned counsel appearing for the AG shall apprise this Court as to the stage of processing of the case for compassionate family pension.

The learned counsel for the petitioner shall supply a copy of the requisite documents to the learned counsel appearing for the AG within 5(five) days.
