Heard Mr. G.R. Dutta, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. C.K.S. Baruah, learned Central Government Counsel [CGC] for all the respondents.

The petitioner is presently serving as Assistant Sub-Inspector of Police in Central Industrial Security Force [CISF]. The petitioner is aggrieved by an Order dated 23.03.2022 whereby penalty of censure had been imposed on him. The said Order of penalty had been affirmed by an Appellate Order dated 06.08.2022. When a revision petition was preferred against the said two Orders, the revision petition was dismissed on the ground of limitation. Hence, the writ petition.
