Heard Ms. M. Nirola, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Ms. D. Mushahary, learned Standing Counsel for Secondary Education Department.

The learned Standing Counsel for the Secondary Education Department submits that in terms of this Court order dated 04.04.2025, a meeting was held on 11.07.2025 by the Secretary, Department of School Education, Assam, wherein the director of the Secondary Education, Assam was also present along with the concerned petitioners.

Accordingly an order was passed that the matter required further examination to determine the issue of provincialisation of Sri Jomil Ahmed and Md. Tariqual Islam. It was decided that a further examination is required with the officials of the Department of School Education in consultation with Finance Department shortly and based on the findings of the examination, a final decision can be taken on the matter.

In view of the above decision/order dated 11.07.2025, the learned Standing Counsel has prayed for another date. The learned counsel for the petitioner has expressed urgency in the matter.

In view of the above, the concerned department is to examine and decide

the matter regarding the provincialisation of the its petitioner within a period of 10 (ten) days and thereafter, list the matter again on 16.09.2025.
