Heard Mr. B. Deori, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner; Ms. R. Dutta, learned counsel appearing for respondent no. 1; and Mr. B.J. Talukdar, learned Additional Senior Government Advocate, Assam assisted by Mr. P. Deka, learned counsel appearing for respondent nos. 4 – 7.

From the office note dated 04.04.2026, it is seen that in the CIS Portal, the name of respondent nos. 9 and 10 have been recorded as 'Ramen Talukdar', whereas, in the cause-title, it is seen that respondent no. 9 is 'Sri Kan Mani Talukdar' and respondent no. 10 is 'Sri Ramen Talukdar'. Therefore, it is seen that there is a mistake in recording the name of respondent no. 9 in CIS Portal as 'Ramen Talukdar' instead of 'Sri Kan Mani Talukdar'.

In view of the aforesaid, Registry is directed to do the needful for correcting and uploading the correct name in respect of respondent no. 9.
