Case taken up before the Lawazima Court.

None appears on behalf of the petitioner.

Perused the records.

The instant matter has been carefully perused and upon such perusal, it has been observed that, vide the Lawazima Court's order dated 10.09.2025, the matter was laid before the Hon'ble Court due to non compliance of the earlier Lawazima Court's orders for taking fresh steps upon the respondent Nos. 4 to 8.

However, in the meantime, the petitioner took fresh steps for issuance of notice to the above mentioned respondents. Accordingly, notice was issued to the respondent Nos. 4 to 8 by way of speed post mode on 02.12.2025.

Now, in respect of the said notice, it appears that neither the A/D cards nor any unserved notices have been received in regard to the notice issued to the respondent Nos. 4 to 8.

However, it appears that the postal track consignment reports regarding the above mentioned notice have been generated and the same have been annexed with the case record at **Flag-'Q' in the Part-III file**. Now, a perusal of the said postal tracking reports reveals that the respective notices of respondent Nos. 4, 5, 6, 7 & 8 have been delivered on 09.12.2025.

In view of the observations made above, it may be presumed that **service of notice upon the respondent Nos. 4 to 8 has been completed.**

Accordingly, the matter may be placed before the Hon'ble Court.
