Heard Mr. T. Deuri, learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner. Also heard Ms. M. Bhattacharjee, learned Additional Senior Government Advocate, Assam appearing for the respondent No. 1 and Mr. S.P. Das, learned counsel appearing for the respondent Nos. 2 and 3.

Ms. Bhattacharjee submits that the question of law involved in this proceeding, is sub-judiced in other pending matters, which are fixed on 14.11.2024. Therefore, this writ petition be also posted on 14.11.2024 along with WP(C) No. 5384/2024 so as to enable her to obtain complete instruction.

Mr. Deuri, learned counsel for the petitioner, on the other hand, submits that the authorities are proceeding with the departmental proceeding, and, therefore, an interim order for protection is called for in this case.

Ms. Bhattacharjee, learned Additional Senior Government Advocate has not opposed to the said prayer.

In view of the above, issue notice of motion, returnable on 14.11.2024.

Since the respondents are already represented, no formal notice is required to be sent in this case.

Extra copies of the writ petition, requisite in numbers, be furnished to the learned departmental counsel, so as to enable them to obtain instruction and file affidavit.
