The petitioner's husband late Kumud Gogoi died in an accident on 09/09/2017. As per the Government notification dated 15/11/2014, the writ petitioner being the next of kin of the deceased, was entitled to ex-gratia relief of Rs. 2 lakhs. However, the said prayer has not been considered till date. As such, the present writ petition has been filed.

Ms. N. Bordoloi, learned Standing Counsel, Revenue and DM Department, Assam, prays for four weeks time to obtain instruction.
