Case taken up before the Lawazima Court.

None appears on behalf of the petitioners.

Perused the records.

Perusal of the instant case record reveals that the instant matter was earlier listed before the Lawazima Court on 12.11.2025 and vide the order passed on the said date, the Lawazima Court was pleased to direct the petitioners to take fresh steps upon the respondent Nos. 4 & 5.

Thereafter, the instant matter was listed before the Lawazima Court again on 15.12.2025 and on that day, the Lawazima Court had observed that no steps for issuance of notice to the respondent Nos. 4 & 5 were received from the petitioners. As such, the Lawazima Court had granted further one week time to take fresh steps upon the respondents mentioned above.

However, despite the repeated directions of the Lawazima Court, no such steps for issuance of notice to the respondent Nos. 4 & 5 have been received from the petitioners.
